The majority of incidents and warnings coming from Neighbourhood Watch in the last year have been related to internet crime, identity fraud and scams. Advice has been distributed to all NHW members on how to protect ourselves from such scams.

Village Matters

In Braybrooke there was a house burglary in April 2016, the police were involved and issued security advice to villagers.

There was also an incident of rogue traders arriving in the village in a white van, falsely claiming to be at a house to carry out inspections or repairs. The authorities reminded villagers not to allow people into our homes unless the visit has been authorised.
