KET/2014/0653: Stuart Howes & Sons, Eckland Lodge: Demolition of agricultural building and erection of workshop and machinery store:

No objections were raised and it was noted that the existing building seemed derelict. Screening with natural planting was requested with no construction traffic being allowed through the village

KET/2014/0654: Stuart Howes & Sons, Eckland Lodge: Demolition of agricultural building and erection of grain store and chemical/fertiliser store:

No objections were raised and it was noted that the existing building seemed derelict. Screening with natural planting was requested with no construction traffic being allowed through the village

KET/2014/0655: Stuart Howes & Sons, Eckland Lodge: Full application with EIA for solar park:

No objections were raised. The application site was considered to show a low level of visual impact. Councillors appreciated the total truthfulness of photographs submitted showing the proposed site, in particular the computer generated images showing the panels in situ. No construction traffic through the village and screening with natural planting were requested. The glint barriers were considered to be inappropriate in this setting.
