- I. Apologies for absence – All Councillors present.
3. There were no declarations of interest.

2&4. A general discussion was held on the proposed solar park, which will cover up to 69.5 hectares. A comparison was drawn between the proposed Harborough Road site and the proposed sites at Burton Latimer believed to be of approx. 34 hectares, Desborough of approx. 36.5 hectares and Eckland Lodge of 8.3 hectares. A small part of the proposed Braybrooke site is over the county border in Leicestershire.

It was decided to encourage attendance at the Ecus Open Forum and to obtain as much information as possible from the forum so that the Parish Council response is one based on information.

5. The Laurels, KBC's new site for Gypsies and Travellers is now up and running.
6. The NCALC update was passed on for circulation between councillors.

Councillors Barwick, Jessop, Normand and Stanley to attend the informal consultation evening at Eckland Lodge on August 27th 2014.

Councillor Normand to pursue a link with Harborough following concern over the increase in heavy vehicles passing through the village.

Councillor Berry reported the availability of community project funding from KBC.
