- 1 Apologies for absence: Cllr Ayton
- 2 Public Participation:
Mrs Misiun spoke to the application KET/2015/00414 and gave a history of the site explaining the reasoning for the application for permanent status.
- 3 Declarations of Interest:
The Chairman and Clerk of Harrington Parish Council explained their presence to demonstrate their continued support and solidarity with Braybrooke in relation to unwarranted developments in open countryside.
- 4 The Parish Council considered the following planning applications:

KET/2015/0041: Mrs Misiun, Hovel Field Stables, Oxendon Lane, Braybrooke: Retention of stables:
There were no objections to this application. It was noted that other adjacent stables had permanent planning permission. The Parish Council considered that a condition should be attached to ensure that the site was to be used solely for agricultural purposes.

KET/2015/0050: Mr and Mrs Clayton, 4 Latymer Close, Braybrooke: Two-storey side extension:
There were no objections to this application. It was noted that there were similar extensions to other houses in the same road.

DA/2015/0083: Golden Stables, Braybrooke Road, Gt Oxenden (Arthingworth Parish) Northamptonshire: Use of land for stationing of two additional mobile homes and associated caravans for family members, extension to day room and extension to stable building:
The Councillors were unanimous in strongly objecting to this application. Exactly the same reasons for objecting pertained to this application as to the previous one for this site which was refused at the planning meeting in Daventry on 28 January 2015. The village was reminded that the deadline for letters is 4 March 2015. Cllr Berry would write to object on behalf of the Parish Council.

5 Any other business:

The Chairman and Clerk from Harrington were thanked for their attendance at the meeting. Close co-operation between adjacent villages is becoming of growing importance.

Cllr Berry would chase KBC for the weekly planning application lists as well as plans approved or declined.

It was noted that a notice that KBC had received additional information regarding the Eckland Lodge solar park had been published on 12 February in the press but no information was received by the Parish Council.

Subsequently established that the additional information were letters of clarification and additional plans.

Cllr Jessop would check the locations of street lights shown on a map and requested by Mr Jim McNally at KBC.
