### A PLANNING MEETING OF THE PARISH COUNCIL WAS HELD ON 21<sup>st</sup> APRIL 2015 AT THE VILLAGE HALL, BRAYBROOKE COMMENCING AT 7.00PM

1 Apologies for absence: None

2 Public Participation:  
Villagers present expressed concern over the influx of applications for Greenfields, Golden Stables and the newly named, The Paddocks, previously Black Paddock. The current group of travelers on the A6 roundabout was also noted.

3 Declarations of Interest: None

4 The Parish Council considered the following planning applications:

DA/2015/0275: Construction of 6 no. brick gate piers (retrospective), Braybrooke Road & Desborough Road, Arthingworth:

It was agreed that the pillars seem very close to the road, and the design is considered to be inappropriate for the location. If permission is granted, the Parish Council asked that they be made less obtrusive. The decision not to object outright to the application was passed 4:1 – Cllr Barwick considered that the application should be opposed. Cllr Berry would write to Daventry District Council.

KET/2014/0774, 0776, 0777, 0778, 0784, 0786, KET/2015/0079: Plots 4A, 4B, 4C, 4D, 9, 8, 8A Greenfields, Braybrooke Road, Braybrooke: Permanent permission for siting of caravans for residential occupation with associated hard standings and cess tanks:

Because of the similarity of these applications, they were taken and discussed together. The Parish Council objected to all these application because the temporary permissions had expired in November 2014 and the site should have been cleared at that time. KBC now has sufficient provision of approved traveller sites elsewhere in the borough to obviate the need to grant these permissions.

KET/2015/0065: The Paddocks, Park Hill, Braybrooke:

Full application: Change of use to permanent traveller site for 3 no. pitches:  
The Parish Council objected to this application on the grounds that permanent permission is not necessary now that KBC has sufficient provision elsewhere.

It is expected that all these application will go before the Planning Committee in due course. Cllr Howes stressed the importance of all villagers responding to all applications

Cllr Berry would write to KBC on behalf of the Parish Council with its objections. Cllr Berry had already written to Daventry District Council with the Parish Council's objections to the recent Golden Stables application.
