

River Warden Report 2019

The externally funded Braybrooke Flood Risk Report was received in 2018 and is available to read on the Parish Council website. It contains maps and surveys of water courses, drains and possible flood areas in the Parish together with guidance on how to maintain these and the further investigations required.

The January meeting of the Parish Council considered in detail the recommendations of the Report, informed by the Parishioners who attended the meeting.

A meeting with the Environment Agency has been arranged to take place in May which will involve an inspection of the Flood Protection Reservoir and to discuss the other recommendations in the report. These include undertaking a survey of the River Jordan and undertaking a programme of clearance works and also undertaking a survey of buried pipework in the Parish. Such programmes of work would require funding external to the Parish Council budget.

The Parish Council is currently compiling a list of key landowners/holders so as to be able to write to them to remind them of their responsibilities for the good maintenance of the River Jordan and other water courses where clearance of excessive vegetation, silt and debris could improve water flow.
